

## Safer Neighbourhood News

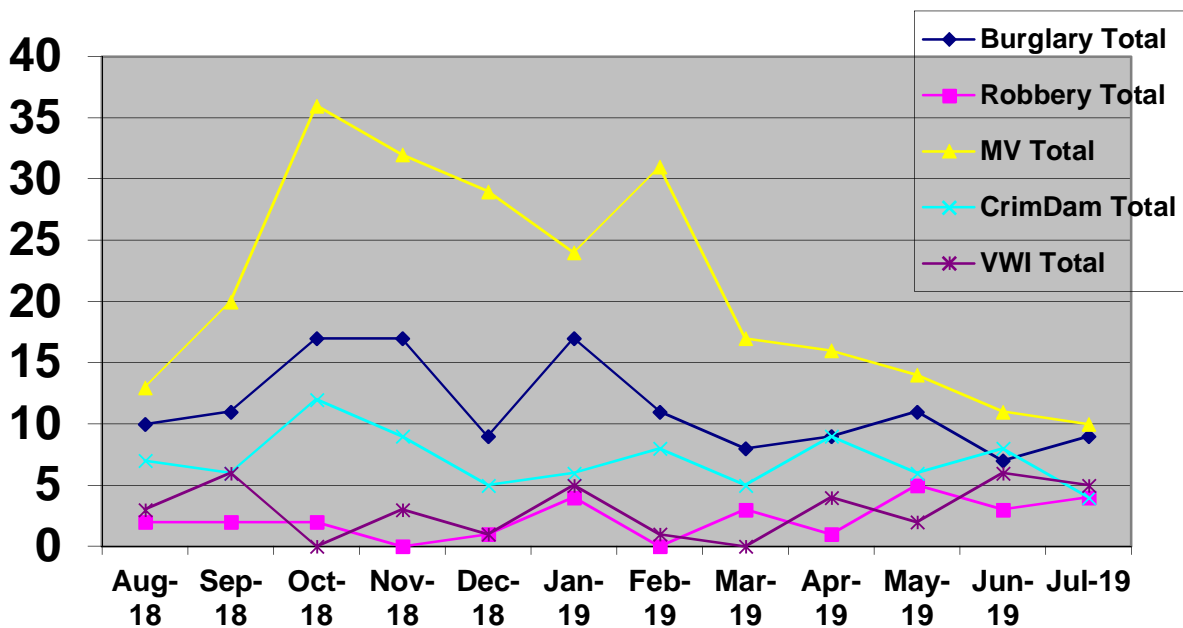

## Crimes Recorded in July

### Burglary
